“Want to create your own infographics, web badges, and tip sheets on teen pregnancy prevention and other adolescent health topics, but don't have time? *The Studio* tool is your answer! With *The Studio*, you can add your organization's logo to materials that have already been fact-checked and approved by the Family and Youth Services Bureau. Within minutes, you'll be able to download and share personalized materials to help increase the visibility and impact of your program.

To access *The Studio* tool and other materials developed exclusively for APP grantees, you need to create an account on *The Exchange*. If you are the primary point of contact for your grant, then you must register before any other project staff can access exclusive content. Each grant can only have one primary contact. Registering takes less than 5 minutes.”

“Just click “Register” in the top right corner, select “APP Grantee Point of Contact”, then complete the form with your name, grant number, email address, organization, and funding type. Once your account is approved and you set your password, you can add project staff by going to “Account” and then “My Grants”. Just enter their names and email addresses, then select “Invite” and they'll immediately receive an email granting access to the site's exclusive content.”
