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





### **Initiate Conversations**


- Beginning of the "trusting" relationship



- Check to see what IRBs and RRBs may be in place


### **Implement the Program**


- Largest and most time-consuming phase
- Includes scheduling, consent forms, rosters, attendance sheets, trainings, etc...
- Consistency is important from implementors and evaluators



### Analyze the Data

- Shows communities how the program is impacting students and tell a story
- Ensure that facilitators understand the data is for their community
- Make data community friendly
