 - Partner with nontraditional settings (alternative schools, job training programs) in Los Angeles & San Diego
 - Engages youth in behavioral changes
 - Primary outcomes:
 - Abstinence or cessation of sexual activity; and
 - Unprotected vaginal intercourse

Not One-Size-Fits-All

Challenges

 Using same model with all partners

Large Staff Turnover

Tips

 Understand how each partner functions and tailor to them

 Be flexible with your implementation model



Having a Champion

Challenges

 Youth not wanting to participate with "strangers"

Tips

 Find an advocate for your program

 Partner staff not understanding our program

 Conduct informational sessions with staff



Communication

Challenges

 Lack of understanding of all aspects of the program

Unable to find youth for follow-up surveys

Tips

 Coordinator to connect with the liaison/champion frequently

 Build relationship & open line with partner staff to help with connecting with youth
