5. Connected but relationships aren't fulfilling



From Theory to Practice



- A. The holistic individual and societal benefits associated with personal responsibility, self-regulation, goal setting, healthy decision-making, and a focus on the future.
 - B. The advantage of refraining from non-marital sexual activity in order to improve the future prospects and physical and emotional health of youth.
 - C. The increased likelihood of avoiding poverty when youth attain self-sufficiency and emotional maturity before engaging in sexual activity.
 - D. The foundational components of healthy relationships and their impact on the formation of healthy marriages and safe and stable families.
 - E. How other youth risk behaviors, such as drug and alcohol usage, increase the risk for teen sex.
 - F. How to resist and avoid, and receive help regarding, sexual coercion and dating violence, recognizing that even with consent teen sex remains a youth risk behavior.

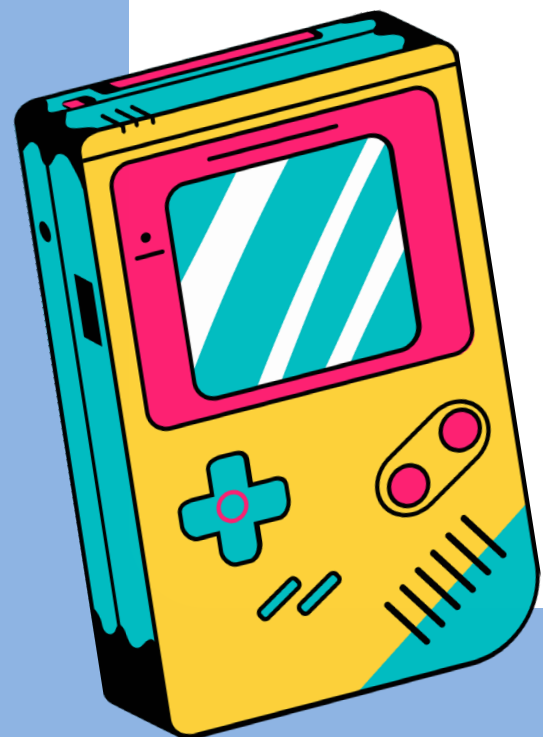


Engaging the Youth

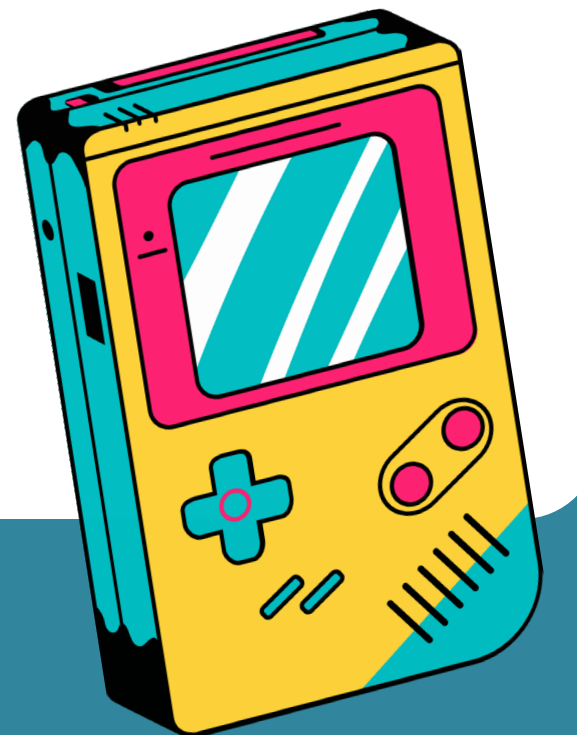


Engaging the Community

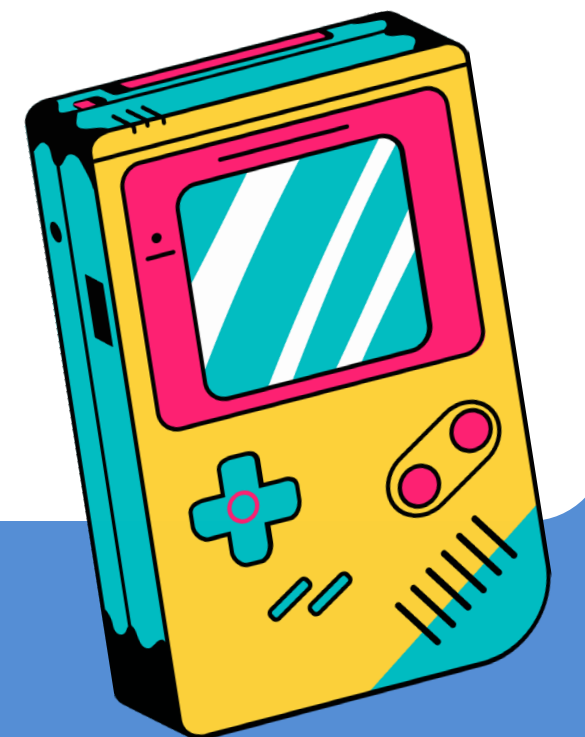
